

PROGRAM: LEADERS AND LEADERSHIP TEAMS TRAINING

ACSL's Leaders and Leadership Team Program will provide learners with comprehensive professional learning about their safeguarding responsibilities within the Catholic Church. This program will support learners to build their organisational safeguarding capacity, including modules on online safeguarding, managing and mitigating safeguarding risks and managing safeguarding complaints effectively at a leadership level.

This program combines interactive and flexible learning. Normally offered over a six week period, across three phases as described below.



Phase 1

The starter half-day workshop is designed to allow Church Leaders and their teams to explore themes of safeguarding culture and compliance.



Phase 2

Self-paced modules are completed and combined with undertaking a safeguarding environmental scan and maintaining a reflective discussion with other learners.



Phase 3

This 90 minute facilitated review workshop and sharing session brings the program to a close.

The training is designed for:

- Church Authorities such as bishops, religious superiors, and trustees of Ministerial PJP's.
- Diocesan, MPJP and religious institute leadership teams.

This training is designed to address NCSS 5.3.2.
